ORDER

Considering the opinion of the Alabama Supreme Court rendered on interlocutory appeal from this proceeding (known as Case No. 1200798), it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

The Defendants in this matter are permanently enjoined from offering "electronic bingo" at any facility in Macon County, from receiving any moneys in relation to "electronic bingo" machines operated in Macon County, from transporting or providing any additional "electronic bingo" machines to any facility in Macon County, and from receiving, utilizing or providing bingo licenses or permits to play "electronic bingo" in Macon County.

This Order is subject to and conditioned upon the law of the State of Alabama as it exists on the day of this Order. If the law of Alabama should subsequently change and should "electronic bingo," as such term is presently known, be legally permitted in Macon County the injunction entered hereto shall be dissolved in all respects, and nothing herein shall prohibit Defendants from engaging in "electronic bingo."
